### **TRAVEL:**

Fly into Portland International Airport (PDX) by July 27th , 2023.

You will need a rental car, Uber or Lyft to get from the airport 45 minutes south to Wilsonville. The meeting room is approximately 5-10 minutes south from the hotel. If you plan on staying in the area longer or exploring the state, we recommend getting a rental car. 4 wheel drive is not necessary. There are plenty of ride-share options in/around Portland, but less options the further out you are.
